Terms and Conditions of Competition

- No competitor may enter more than one category.
- Entrants must be the sole author and owner of copyright for all photos entered.
- Belfast City Council retains the right to free reproduction and exhibition of all entries. By sending a photograph to us you grant permission for the council to publish the photograph, or any part of it, in any media it chooses, including its website. No payment will be made by the council for the use of your photograph.
- Entries must be accompanied by an official entry form.
- Before submitting the entry, photographers must seek the permission from anyone who is recognisable in the photo or the permission of guardians for photographs of minors or those with learning disabilities.
- Entrants may not manipulate the image. Judges reserve the right to exclude any image that they believe has been excessively treated so as to alter its authenticity.
- All entries are sent at the photographer's own risk and Belfast City Council cannot accept liability for damage or loss (whether or not there is receipt of posting).
- No more than one prize will be awarded to any entrant in the same category.
- A panel of judges will choose the winning photos. The decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- No employee of Belfast City Council, Bloomingdale Nurseries or the Morrow Group may enter the competition.

The closing date for the competition is 4.00pm on Friday 21 May 2010.

An award ceremony for the winning entrants will take place in June/July 2010. A selection of photographs entered into the competition will be on display at Sir Thomas and Lady Dixon Park during Rose Week which will run from Tuesday 13 to Sunday 18 July 2010.

Your photograph may include:

- people enjoying themselves out and about in parks in Belfast

To be eligible, your photograph must have been taken after January 2009. It must also have been taken from an area of the park that's available to the public.

The competition is open to club photographers and members of the public, although we cannot accept photographs that have won prizes in other external competitions or photographs that were entered into a previous Belfast Parks photographic competition.

You should submit your photograph in both:

- colour print, and
- digital format (via CD or DVD).

The size, format and resolution should be suitable for printing and publications.

Prizes will be awarded in the following categories:

(a) Best photograph by a club photographer

First prize £250, second prize £150, third prize £100.

Entrants must be members of a recognised camera club.

To enter, you need to submit:

- up to three colour prints between 8" x 6" and 10" x 12" mounted on black card, and
- the same photographs in digital format.

(b) Best photograph by member of the public

First prize £175, second prize £100, third prize £75.

Open to all members of the public.

To enter you need to submit:

- up to three colour prints, enprint size up to a maximum of 7" x 5" unmounted, and
- the same photographs in digital format.

(c) Best under 16 photograph

First prize £75, second prize £50, third prize £25.

To enter you need to submit:

- up to three colour prints, enprint size up to a maximum of 7" x 5" unmounted, and
- the same photographs in digital format.
