

Creepy Chalk Creatures

Use your creative skills when drawing huge mini-beast pictures.

Once the pupils have observed all the mini-beasts they have found they can draw their favourite one. WtS! Officers did this as a group activity using a large black mat and chalk. The children take it in turns to draw with the chalk, with the rest of the class helping them with the detail – does the mini-beast have antennae? Is the body segmented? Does the creature have legs and if so, how many? This activity really helps the children look closely at the mini-beasts and understand their structure.
