

Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997

Notice of Proposed Special Event

Notice is hereby given that Belfast City Council by virtue of the powers conferred on it by Article 8A of and Schedule 3A to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997 is minded to make an Order to temporarily restrict or prohibit all traffic from using the following roads in accordance with the details in the schedule hereto to facilitate the safe operation of Filming organised by **Josh Suter**. Where necessary, local diversions will be in operation, signed as appropriate during the times stated below or until the time the event is announced by the organiser as completed, whichever is the earlier, the right of way on the road, vehicles and other forms of traffic shall be restricted or prohibited.

- Road Closure - Great Patrick Street (from Dunbar Link to Corporation Street)
- Road Closure - Tomb Street (from Corporation Square to Gamble Street)
- Road Closure - Trafalgar Street (from Corporation Street to Nelson Street)
