

# Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997 Notice of Proposed Special Event

**Notice is hereby given** that Belfast City Council by virtue of the powers conferred on it by Article 8A of and Schedule 3A to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997 is minded to make an Order to temporarily restrict or prohibit all traffic from using the following roads in accordance with the details in the Schedule hereto to facilitate the safe operation of filming organised by **Robert Huffam**. Where necessary, local diversions will be in operation, signed as appropriate during the times stated below or until the time the event is announced by the organiser as completed, whichever is the earlier, the right of way on the road, vehicles and other forms of traffic shall be restricted or prohibited.

## **Monday 2 March from 7am to Friday 6 March 2026 at 8pm. Access to residents will be maintained.**

- Road Closure - Beechmount Drive (from Falls Road to Ballymurphy Street).
- Road Closure - Ballymurphy Street (from Beechmount Drive to Clowney Street). Re-opened during overnight hours.
- Road Closure - Beechmount Parade (from a point 50mts West of Ballymurphy Street to a point 50m East of Ballymurphy Street).

## **Thursday 12 March 2026 from 9am to 7pm.**

- Road Closure - Glenties Drive (from junction of Falcarragh Drive).
- Temporary Traffic Control at: Falcarragh Drive (at junction of Kerrykeel Gardens and junction of Falcarragh Drive number 23).

## **Monday 16 March 2026 from 9am to 11pm, Wednesday 18 March 2026 from 7am to 8pm, and Thursday 19 March 2026 from 8am to 10pm.**

- Road Closure - Colinview Street (at junction of Springfield Road to Forfar Street).
  - Temporary Traffic Control at:
    - Junction of Forfar Street and Elwick Street.
    - Colinpark Street and Forfar Street.
    - Forfar Street (at junction of Millenium Way).
    - Colinward Street (at junction of Springfield Road).
