

Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997 Notice of Proposed Special Event

Notice is hereby given that Belfast City Council by virtue of the powers conferred on it by Article 8A of and Schedule 3A to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997 is minded to make an Order to temporarily restrict or prohibit all traffic from using the following roads in accordance with the details in the Schedule hereto to facilitate the safe operation of filming organised by **Robert Huffam**. Where necessary, local diversions will be in operation, signed as appropriate during the times stated below or until the time the event is announced by the organiser as completed, whichever is the earlier, the right of way on the road, vehicles and other forms of traffic shall be restricted or prohibited.

Road Closure: Clarence Street (from Adelaide Street to Alfred Street)

Temporary Traffic Control on: Alfred Street (at the junction of Clarence Street)

Road Closure: Joy Street (from Hamilton Street to May Street)

Wednesday 25 and Thursday 26 March 2026, 9am to 10pm

Road Closure: Massey Court (from junction of Massey Avenue)
