

Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997 Notice of Proposed Special Event

Notice is hereby given that Belfast City Council by virtue of the powers conferred on it by Article 8A of and Schedule 3A to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997 is minded to make an Order to temporarily restrict or prohibit all traffic from using the following roads in accordance with the details in the Schedule hereto to facilitate the safe operation of filming organised by David Cooke. Where necessary, local diversions will be in operation, signed as appropriate during the times stated below or until the time the event is announced by the organiser as completed, whichever is the earlier, the right of way on the road, vehicles and other forms of traffic shall be restricted or prohibited.

Monday 13, Tuesday 14, Wednesday 15 and Saturday 25 June 2022: 7.30am to 8pm.

- Closure: Mountcollyer Street, Glencollyer Street, Mileriver Street, Limestone Road (section between Mileriver Street and Clanchattan Street).
- Stop/Go: Limestone Road (main road).

Tuesday 14, Wednesday 15, Thursday 16 and Monday 27 June 2022: 9.30am to 9.30pm.

- Closure: Ballygomartin Drive and Ballygomartin Road.

Monday 13, Tuesday 14 and Wednesday 15 June 2022: 7.30 to 8pm.

- Closure: Wellwood Street, Glenalpin Street, Norwood Street.
- Stop/Go: Sandy Row.

Wednesday 15, Thursday 16, Friday 17 June 2022: 6am on Wednesday to 11pm Friday.

- Closure: Library Street, Little Donegall Street, Kent Street, Union Street, Unity Walk and Stephen Street.

Monday 20 through to Friday 24 June 2022 inclusive: 8am to 8.30pm.

- Closure: Beverly Street, Carlow Street, Cumberland Street, Percy Street, Percy Place, Dover Street, Loudon Street, Boundary Street, Cargill Street and Dayton Street (access for residents only).
- Stop/Go: Townsend Street.

- Closure: Carrigart Avenue, Creeslough Park, Derryveagh Drive, Horn Drive and Doon Road.
