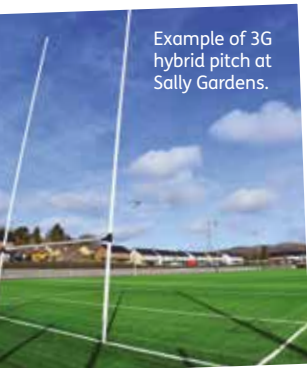

3G Hybrid pitch and changing pavilion

Work has now started on an all-weather 3G artificial pitch and four room changing pavilion. This state-of-the-art facility will encourage participation in sport, improve health and wellbeing opportunities and encourage positive use of the park.

We're working to improve the environment around Whiterock Leisure Centre, providing new facilities, increasing community activity and participation and encouraging people to use services. Work is ongoing and so far we have developed a new playground, a multi-use games area, a car park, Glór Na Móna school buildings and a landscaped open space. We've also completed community gardens and allotments at the site.

Falls Park Masterplan Projects



We have received funding from the Heritage Lottery Fund's Parks for People Programme to develop a large scale heritage project in City Cemetery. The project is designed to protect, enhance and maximise the heritage and biodiversity potential of the cemetery and enable more people to access and understand it. This work will involve a number of projects including developing a visitor and community space, restoring key heritage assets, telling the stories of the site and developing promotional activities.
